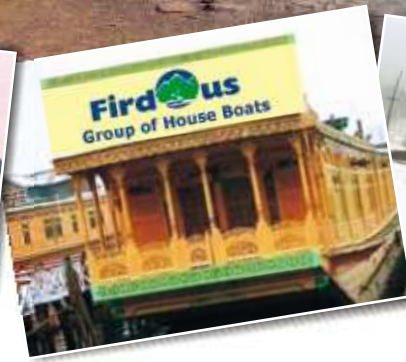


Welcome to paradise

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Kashmir is a multi faced diamond set like a jewel on the map of India. Surrounded by two major Himalayan ranges, the Great Pir Panjal and Nanga Parbat. Mughals aptly called Kashmir “paradise on earth”. They traveled a long distances to spend the summer in its cool environs, where they discovered the valleys fabled hill station and laid Srinagar's famous Mughal gardens Nishat and Shalimar. They also patronized the development of art and craft left behind a rich heritage of exquisite artisanship.

Kashmir is famous for its four distinctive seasons, each with its own peculiar character, charm and extravagantly beautiful. Spring (March-May) sees a million blossoms carpeting the ground. In summer (June-August) the whole valley turns into mosaic of varying green shades. In autumn (September- October) the green shades turn entirely into the Gold. In winter (December-March) the valley is entirely in the different mood as the landscapes becomes bare, soon to be covered by the white mantle of first snowfall. Watching that entire scenario, cannot be described, but only experienced.

Day one: Srinagar

On arrival at Srinagar airport, you will meet our representative and transfer you to houseboat or hotel. Afternoon free for personal activities.

Day 2 : Srinagar to Gulmarg

(2,370 m / 56 kms)

After breakfast leave to Gulmarg known as “the meadows of flowers”, which is located at the height of 2,370 meters above the sea level. Which is one of the most beautiful summer resorts in the valley. It is also known for its world's 18 hole golf course in (summer) the highest in the world, and skiing during in the winter season. One can enjoy the breathtaking natural views of snow-covered mountains through the cable care (gulmarg gondola) from gulmarg to the Khilangmarg. Full day trip, and back to Srinagar



Day 3: Srinagar local sight seeing

(1,700 m / 50 kms)

Located at the heart of Kashmir valley, Srinagar is famous for its lakes and houseboat's on the famous dal lake and Mughal gardens, Nested under the mighty Zabarvan Mountains.

Half-day tour to famous dal lake in the shikara (boat) through golden dal-lake char chinar, and floating gardens, and many places of interests. Nested between famous dal-lake and zabarwan hills are famous mughal gardens with their terraced lawns, cascading fountains and bright flowerbeds, over looking the panorama of the Dal-lake. **Shalimar** (15 km) is called (the abode of love), was built by by Emperor Jahangir for his wife Nur jehan. **Nishat bagh** (11 km) is called (the garden of pleasure), was designed in 1633 ad by asif khan, brother of nur jehan. **Chashmashahi** (royal spring), the spring of refreshing sweet water cherished by the mughals.on near by spur of the mountain is the ancient monument **parimahal**, planed out by Dara Shikoh. Take the ride

On the shore of dal lake, at the top of takti-I-sulaimani hill is the ancient monument known as **shankaracharya temple** (250 BC) built high octagonal plinth. a part from sightseeing, Kashmir is shoppers paradise, magic Kashmir carpet, shawls and many more things.



Day 4: Srinagar to Pahalgam

(2,130 m / 90 kms)

After break fast drive to Pahalgam, which is also known as "the valley of Shepard's", is situated at the confluence of the **sheshnag** and the Cascading water of **Lidder stream**, known for its lush green mountain slopes. Which are unforgettable for nature lovers it is Kashmir's premier summer resort, cool even during the heights of summer. The resort is surrounded by many places of interest like mamal, chandamwari, and way to amaranth ji shrine. One can enjoy many interesting activities like golf, fishing, rafting, and many more. On the way to pahalgam one can glimpse the beautiful saffron fields and in the Avantipur, which ruins eleven hundred old temples, which is also famous place of film industry. By lunchtime you will reach to the pahalgam. On can enjoy the mind blowing scenic beauty of pahalgam.full day trip, and back to Srinagar.



Day 5: Srinagar to sonamarg

(2,730 m / 84 km)

Sonamarg " the meadow of gold", lies at the head of the sind valley. Blossoms Colorful Mountains and thick pine forests surrounds the Sonamarg. The Sind valley is crowned by the mighty and magnificent mountain "the thajiwas glacier", presents a spectacular view, which remains frozen through out the year. Adventure by the pony trekking is also possible. The major trek passing of several magnificent mountains and beautiful lakes such as **Kishnuser, Krishnasar, Gadsar, Gangbal**, valley.sonamarg also serves as the base for the holy amaranth cave from baltal rote. Full day trip, and back to Srinagar.

Day 6 : Srinagar to yusmarg (50 km)

One of the captivating meadows of Kashmir “meadow of flowers”. Yousmarg is not just a meadow, but also clusters of meadows bounded by magnificent trees in the lap of pirpanjal mountain range. The place is simply bewitching, where man is lost in nature and awed with its beauty. **Mt Tatkoti**, which is the source of famous **Dood Gnga** stream, which is one km away from sonamarg, where one can go on pony or enjoy the environs by footing the distance. Down hill four km from yousmarg is a beautiful blue water lake known, as Nil nag the place is a wonderful picnic spot, where tourists are mesmerized by wonderful nature. Full day trip, and back to Srinagar.



Day 7: Srinagar

Transfer to the Srinagar airport on time to connect the destination flight.
